As historians:
 We will look at toys from the past and identify which materials they are made from and how they move. We will compare old and new toys.

As geographers:
 We will explore our local area learning important mapping and field skills. We will also be comparing our village with our twinned village Longny-Au-Perche and looking at key physical and human geography in the UK and abroad.

As mathematicians:
 We will be very busy learning addition and subtraction of numbers up to 20. Place value up to 50. Multiples of 2, 5 and 10. This term will also cover the area of measurement.

As design and technologists:
 We will design and make a purposeful toy using a mechanism and then evaluate our ideas and products against the original design criteria. Will our toys need to have a force applied to them to make them move?

As scientists:
 We will identify and sort materials and their properties. We shall change materials by heating, freezing, melting and applying forces. We will create a fair test and record our results. We shall look at and explore simple forces.

As linguists:
 We will continue to write for a variety of purposes. We shall also think about word classes - nouns, verbs and adjectives. We shall learn how to write longer sentences by putting 'and' in them. We will learn how to use full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
